Upcoming Schedule of Vaccine Clinics at the Harvey Convention Center Tyler, Texas (Tuesday, April 13, 2021)

First Dose PFIZER Vaccine Appointments Are Now Available

This Wednesday April 14th and this Thursday April 15th, anyone over the age of 16 can obtain the first Pfizer vaccine at the Harvey Convention Center between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Appointments are recommended but are not required and Pfizer vaccines will be provided based upon the supply that is made available for each day.

“Anyone interested in receiving their first COVID vaccine can come to the Harvey Convention Center this Wednesday or Thursday,” says George Roberts, NET Health CEO. “We encourage interested persons to make an appointment selecting your preferred day and time by visiting NETHealthCOVID19.org and clicking the ‘Vaccine Updates’ link. On this webpage, anyone can view the available appointment times to receive your first or your second Pfizer vaccine.”

For Persons Needing Their Second Dose PFIZER Vaccine

Persons who received their first Pfizer vaccine on Monday March 29th, Saturday March 27th, Friday March 26th, or on any previous day, are invited to receive their second Pfizer vaccine this Friday or Saturday, April 16th or April 17th, at the Harvey Convention Center in Tyler between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

For this Friday or Saturday, April 16th or April 17th, appointments for persons to receive their second Pfizer vaccine are recommended but not required, as long as the individual shows their “CDC COVID Vaccination Record Card” that they were given when the first Pfizer vaccine was administered. Persons who received their first Pfizer vaccine at least 21 days before March 30th from any vaccine provider can receive their second Pfizer vaccine from NET Health by visiting the “Vaccine Updates” link at NETHealthCOVID19.org.
